Vintage: Clothing from the past that is worn again (the original clothing, not copies)	Examples:
Haute Couture: French term meaning "fine tailoring." One of a kind garments made to fit a specific person. Very expensive.	Examples:
Designer Label: Cross between couture and mass market. Made of quality materials in limited quantities, not made for individual customers	Examples:
Mass Market: Ready to wear clothing made in large quantities and in standard sizes. Less expensive materials, more affordable.	Examples:
